

**RESOLUTION NO. 2015-32**

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE APPLICATION FOR, AND IF AWARDED, THE ACCEPTANCE OF, A GRANT FROM THE FEDERAL UNIVERSAL SERVICE FUND (e-RATE) FOR SCHOOLS AND LIBRARIES, FOR STATE FISCAL YEAR 2015-2016 FOR TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES WHEREBY THE GRANT PROVIDES FOR A 90% REIMBURSEMENT TO THE CITY OF HIALEAH FOR INTERNET CHARGES, AND A 70% REIMBURSEMENT TO THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FOR TELECOMMUNICATIONS SERVICES.

**WHEREAS**, the City of Hialeah finds it in its best interest to continue a program for discounted internet and telecommunications services for the JFK Library funded in part by the Federal Universal Service Fund for Schools and Libraries; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Hialeah, through its Library Division, has successfully participated in this program for 18 years.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

**Section 1:** The foregoing facts and recitations contained in the preamble to this resolution are hereby adopted and incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein.

**Section 2:** The Mayor and the City Council of the City of Hialeah, Florida hereby authorize the application for, and the acceptance of, a grant from the Federal Universal Service Fund (e-Rate) for Schools and Libraries, for State Fiscal Year 2015-2016 for Telecommunications services whereby the grant provides for a 90% reimbursement to the


City of Hialeah for internet charges, and a 70% reimbursement to the City of Hialeah, for Telecommunications services.


