

RESOLUTION NO.: 2015-47

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE TOTALING AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$12,057.84 FROM THE LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUND - *FEDERAL*, FOR THE PURCHASE OF SWAT TACTICAL UNIFORMS FROM LOU'S POLICE DISTRIBUTOR'S, INC., LOWEST QUOTED VENDOR, UPON SUCH COSTS HAVING BEEN APPROVED BY THE CHIEF OF POLICE.

WHEREAS, the City of Hialeah Police Department's SWAT unit and Fire Department's SWAT medics respond to, and train for, many scenes in which subjects are armed with various types of weapons, including high powered assault rifles; and

WHEREAS, the current SWAT uniforms are older and are showing signs of wear and tear from training and work; and

WHEREAS, SWAT tactical uniforms are necessary to properly outfit and train these officers; and

WHEREAS, the funds to cover these necessary and legitimate expenses are available in the Law Enforcement Trust Fund- *Federal*; and


WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has recommended adoption of this resolution and determined that the proposed expenditure complies with the provisions of *Guide To Equitable Sharing*.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:


