

RESOLUTION NO. 2015-64

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF UNENCUMBERED APPROPRIATION BALANCES OR A PORTION THEREOF BETWEEN CLASSIFICATIONS OF EXPENDITURES FROM ONE DEPARTMENT TO ANOTHER WITHIN THE GENERAL FUND; WITHIN THE SPECIAL REVENUE FUNDS, AND IN PARTICULAR, THE STREETS TRANSPORTATION FUND, E-911 NON-WIRELESS FUND, FIRE PREVENTION FUND, FIRE RESCUE TRANSPORT FUND, URBAN AREA SECURITY GRANT FUND, AFFORDABLE HOUSING FUND, HIALEAH CIRCULATOR FUND, 3-CENT LOCAL OPTION GAS TAX FUND, ECS & LIBRARY GRANTS FUND AND THE BUILDING DEPARTMENT FUND AND WITHIN ENTERPRISE FUNDS, IN PARTICULAR, AND STORMWATER UTILITY FUND, ALL AS SUMMARIZED AND ITEMIZED IN THE SCHEDULE ATTACHED AS EXHIBIT "1" AND MADE A PART HEREOF.

WHEREAS, the City Administration, by and through its Office of Budget and Management, based on actual experience for during the first six months of Fiscal Year 2014-2015, requests that certain line item adjustments be approved by the City of Hialeah with the understanding that the net effect of all adjustment will not increase or decrease the budget of the General Fund and the budgets of designated Special Revenue Funds and Enterprise Funds of the City.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The Mayor and the City Council of the City of Hialeah, Florida hereby authorize the transfer of unencumbered appropriation balances or a portion thereof between classifications of expenditures from one department to another within the General Fund; within the Special Revenue Funds, in particular, the Streets Transportation Fund, E-911 Non-Wireless Fund, Fire Prevention Fund, Fire Rescue Transport Fund, Urban Area Security Grant Fund,

Hialeah Circulator Fund, Affordable Housing Fund, 3-Cent Local Option Gas Tax Fund, ECS & Library Grants Fund and the Building Department Fund and within Enterprise Funds, in particular, and Stormwater Utility Fund, all as summarized and itemized in the schedule attached as Exhibit "1" and made a part hereof.

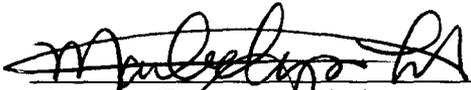
