## PUBLIC EDUCATION FACILITIES ELEMENT

AMENDMENTS INCLUDING A PUBLIC EDUCATION FACILITIES ELEMENT AND RELATED AMENDMENTS TO THE CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS ELEMENT AND INTERGOVERNMENTAL COORDINATION ELEMENT AND EXECUTED PUBLIC SCHOOL INTERLOCAL AGREEMENT

On May 29th, 2009 Resolution 09-62, authorized the Mayor, on behalf of the City, to enter into the Revised Interlocal Agreement for School Facility Planning in Miami-Dade County with the School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida (as adopted by Miami-Dade County and approved by DCA and the School Board of Miami-Dade County). The City of Hialeah entered into the Revised Interlocal Agreement (ILA) for Public School Facility Planning in Miami-Dade County with the School Board of Miami-Dade County, Florida. The City of Hialeah is now proposing to amend its comprehensive plan to incorporate the ILA, Public Education Facilities Element (PEFE) and related amendments to the Capital Improvements Element and Intergovernmental Coordination Element. The PEFE and ILA are transmitted as a proposed amendment under Section 163.3184, FS.

In support of the proposed amendment, the City of Hialeah is opting to rely upon the data and analysis provided by Miami-Dade County in their document entitled Supporting Data and Analysis for the Special Application Requesting Amendments to Miami-Dade County Comprehensive Development Master Plan Addressing Public Schools Facilities, dated July 3, 2007, as prepared by Miami-Dade County Department of Planning and Zoning, and as supplemented in 2010 to include the Miami-Dade School Board's adopted 2010-2011 through 2014-15 District Facilities Work Plan, and as further supplemented by the Miami-Dade County School Board's 2010 Updated Analysis of Level of Service Standards.
