RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, NAMING THE MEMBERS OF THE PLANNING AND ZONING BOARD AS THE HEALTHIER HIALEAH ADVISORY COMMITTEE TO ASSIST THE CITY OF HIALEAH MAKE STRATEGIC DECISIONS ABOUT THE POLICIES AND OBJECTIVES OF THE COMPLETE STREETS PROJECT, MAKE RECOMMENDATIONS ON PROGRAM NEEDS, POLICY CHANGES AND IMPROVEMENTS TO INFRASTRUCTURE AND SERVICES WITH A FOCUS ON DEVELOPING A CITY-WIDE COMPREHENSIVE PLAN THAT WILL IMPROVE MOBILITY, ADVOCATE THE HEALTH BENEFITS OF AN ACTIVE LIFESTYLE AND THAT WILL POSITIVELY IMPACT THE HEALTH AND WELL-BEING OF THE RESIDENTS OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH.

WHEREAS, it is the desire of the Mayor and City Council for the City of Hialeah to name the members of the Planning and Zoning Board to an ad hoc advisory committee to assist the City in developing and implementing a Complete Streets Plan, under the Healthier Hialeah Project designed to improve mobility and encourage its residents to lead an active life style;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The City of Hialeah hereby names the appointed members of the Planning and Zoning Board as the Healthier Hialeah Steering Committee to assist the City in developing and implementing its Complete Streets Project and making strategic decisions about the policies and objective of the Project.

Section 2: The Committee has the power and authority to make recommendations on program needs, recommend changes to policies and objectives,

recommend improvements to infrastructure and services with a focus on developing a city-wide comprehensive plan that will improve mobility, advocate the health benefits of an active lifestyle and that will positively impact the health and well-being of the residents of the City of Hialeah.


