

RESOLUTION NO. 2022-133

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE ALLOCATION OF ADMINISTRATIVE FUNDS, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$706,620.40, FOR THE MONITORING AND COMPLIANCE OF COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT-CORONAVIRUS (CDBG-CV) FUNDS THAT WERE PREVIOUSLY ACCEPTED BY THE CITY VIA RESOLUTION NUMBER 2021-100.

WHEREAS, the City accepted the award of \$3,533,102.00 of Community Development Block Grant- Coronavirus (CDBG-CV) on August 1, 2021 via Resolution No. 2021-100; and

WHEREAS, the Mayor and City Council approved activities to be funded by CDBG-CV funds at its October 11, 2022 meeting via Item H on its Consent Agenda; and

WHEREAS, the City is required to ensure that CDBG-CV funds are used in compliance with federal rules and regulations;

WHEREAS, the CDBG-CV program allows for up to twenty (20) percent of its funds to be used for administration and compliance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:


Section 1: The foregoing facts and recitations contained in the preamble to this resolution are hereby adopted and incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein.

Section 2: The City of Hialeah, Florida hereby authorizes the appropriation of \$706,620.40 for the administration of the City's CDBG-CV Program and further authorizes the Mayor or the Grants and Human Services Director to execute, amend, and submit any and all agreements and documents in furtherance thereof. All actions taken to date by officers of the City in furtherance of the acceptance of the grant award and performance of the grant are hereby approved, confirmed, ratified.

Section 3: The City hereby authorizes the Mayor, or his designee, and the City Clerk, as an attesting witness, to execute any and all agreements required in furtherance of this Resolution.

Section 4: This Resolution shall become effective when passed by the City Council and signed by the Mayor or at the next regularly scheduled City Council meeting, if the Mayor's signature is withheld or if the City Council overrides the Mayor's veto.






