

RESOLUTION NO. 2023-009

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, RESPECTFULLY URGING THE FLORIDA LEGISLATURE TO APPROPRIATE FUNDS TO FUND THE EXPENSE OF CERTAIN CAPITAL IMPROVEMENTS TO THE CITY'S SEWER SYSTEM IN THE AMOUNT OF \$1.2 MILLION DOLLARS, REPRESENTING 80% OF THE TOTAL ESTIMATED COSTS OF THE PROJECTS, TO WHICH THE CITY WILL MATCH FUNDING IN AN AMOUNT EQUAL TO NO LESS THAN 20% OF THE TOTAL COSTS OF THE PROJECTS.

WHEREAS, the City of Hialeah respectfully urges the Florida Legislature to appropriate funds to fund sewer lining of basin 001 and rehabilitation of Pump Station 008; and

WHEREAS, the pump station reconstruction consists of internal pumps, electrical controls, and other improvements to the pump structure, needed to meet the Miami-Dade County Code requirements for operating the pump ordered by a Federal Consent Decree; and

WHEREAS, the sewer lining is for the rehabilitation of sewer main lines to prevent ground water infiltration into the sewer system to ensure efficient and proper operation of the sewer systems.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The Florida Legislature is hereby respectfully urged to appropriate funds to fund the expenditure of certain capital improvements to the city's sewer system including sewer lining of Basin 001 and rehabilitation of Pump Station 008 in the amount of \$1.2 million dollars, representing 80% of the estimated cost of the projects, to which the City will match funding in an amount equal to no less than 20% of the total costs of the vehicle.

Section 2: The City of Hialeah, Florida hereby authorizes the Mayor or his designee on behalf of the City to prepare, execute and submit all necessary applications, certifications and documents in furtherance of this funding or appropriations request.

Section 3: The City Clerk is authorized to send a copy of this Resolution as is necessary to accomplish the goal of obtaining funding such other agencies or persons as may be deemed necessary.




