

RESOLUTION NO.: 2015-110

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, RATIFYING THE MAYOR'S APPROVAL OF AN EXPENDITURE TOTALING AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$157,480.00 FROM THE LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUND - *FEDERAL*, FOR THE PURCHASE OF EIGHT (8) 2015 CHEVROLET IMPALA POLICE PACKAGE VEHICLES FROM LOU BACHRODT COCONUT CREEK CHEVROLET, UTILIZING THE PRICING ESTABLISHED BY A COMPETITIVE BID FROM THE FLORIDA SHERIFF'S ASSOCIATION, BID #14-22-0904, UPON SUCH COSTS BEING APPROVED BY THE CHIEF OF POLICE.

WHEREAS, due to the transient nature of the criminal element it has been necessary to send Detectives across the state to the west coast and points north to investigate crimes; and

WHEREAS, the aging Police Department fleet is not dependable for long trips; and

WHEREAS, these vehicles will be used for day-to-day operations and for investigative trips outside of the southeast Florida area; and

WHEREAS, the Police Department wishes to purchase eight (8) Chevrolet Impala police package vehicles from Lou Bachrodt Coconut Creek Chevrolet, utilizing the pricing established by a competitive bid from the Florida Sheriff's Association; and


WHEREAS, the funds to cover these necessary and legitimate expenses are available in the Law Enforcement Trust Fund - *Federal*; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has recommended adoption of this resolution and determined that the proposed expenditure complies with the *Guide to Equitable Sharing*; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. The Mayor and the City Council of the City of Hialeah, Florida, hereby ratify the Mayor's approval of the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$157,480.00 from the Law Enforcement Trust Fund - *Federal* to purchase eight (8) Chevrolet Impala police package vehicles from Lou Bachrodt Coconut Creek Chevrolet, utilizing the pricing established by a competitive bid from the Florida Sheriff's Association, upon such costs having been approved by the Chief of Police.







