RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING THE FLORIDA FINANCIAL LITERACY INITIATIVE GRANT 2015 IN THE AMOUNT OF \$5,000.00 FROM THE FLORIDA COALITION INC. 




