

**RESOLUTION NO. 2015-158**

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA ACCEPTING A GRANT AWARD FROM THE STATE OF FLORIDA, DEPARTMENT OF EDUCATION IN THE AMOUNT OF \$500,000.00, TO PAY FOR THE COSTS OF CONSTRUCTION OF THE NEW TWO-STORY BUILDING AT THE CITY OF HIALEAH EDUCATIONAL ACADEMY; AND FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE ON BEHALF OF THE CITY TO EXECUTE ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS IN FURTHERANCE THEREOF; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, the City of Hialeah is continuously searching for available grants as a source of funding to support the maintenance and growth of its charter school and quality education programming; and


**WHEREAS**, it is in the best interest and welfare of the community to accept this grant award to pay for the costs of construction of the new charter school facilities.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

**Section 1:** The City of Hialeah, Florida hereby accepts a grant award from the State of Florida, Department of Education in the amount of \$500,000.00, to pay for the costs of construction for a new two-story building at the City of Hialeah Educational Academy and further authorizing the Mayor or his designee on behalf of the City to execute all necessary documents in furtherance thereof. All action taken to date by officers of the City in furtherance of the performance of this agreement is hereby approved, confirmed and ratified.




