Early voting to elect the four Councilmembers, Groups I, II, III and IV, will be conducted at the **John F. Kennedy (J.F.K.) Library**, located at **190 West 49 Street, Hialeah, FL**, during a 7-day early voting period, from October 30, 2023 through November 5, 2023 for the Primary and a 3-day early voting period, from November 17, 2023 through November 19, 2023, for the General Election, as follows:
