

RE: Administrative Directive - Use of primary care facilities for work-related injuries

The City of Hialeah requires the use of primary care facilities for work-related injuries. Unless the employee is experiencing a life threatening injury, all City employees that are injured on the job are required to access the following facilities for treatment:
