RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE TOTALING AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$35,150.00 FROM THE LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUND – *FEDERAL*, TO PURCHASE 40 BROTHER RUGGEDJET DT MOBILE PRINTERS WITH POWER ADAPTERS AND APPLICABLE WARRANTIES, UTILIZING PUBLIC NATIONAL IPA TECHNOLOGY SOLUTIONS CONTRACT NO. 2018011-01 WITH CDW GOVERNMENT, LLC, AN AUTHORIZED DISTRIBUTOR, AND WAIVING COMPETITIVE BIDDING AS IT IS ADVANTAGEOUS TO THE CITY, UPON SUCH COSTS HAVING BEEN APPROVED BY THE CHIEF OF POLICE.

WHEREAS, electronic citation technology and mobile reporting options have been implemented by the Hialeah Police Department; and

WHEREAS, in order to continue to enhance this program, the Hialeah Police Department seeks to purchase durable, fast, high quality mobile printers recharged by power adapters for its patrol vehicle fleet; and

WHEREAS, by printing when required, mobile printers reduce the risk of clerical errors enabling officers to further avoid unnecessary time consuming paperwork;

WHEREAS, outfitting Hialeah Police Department patrol vehicles with rugged, field reliable mobile printers that withstand the weather and allow law enforcement officers to issue and quickly print high resolution traffic citations and documents will improve safety and efficiency; and


WHEREAS, the funds to cover these necessary and legitimate expenses are available in the Law Enforcement Trust Fund - *Federal*; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has recommended adoption of this resolution and determined that the proposed expenditure complies with the *Guide to Equitable Sharing*.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:


Section 1. The Mayor and the City Council of the City of Hialeah, Florida, approve the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$35,150.00 from the Law Enforcement Trust Fund – *Federal*, to purchase 40 Brother Ruggedjet DT mobile printers with power adapters and applicable warranties, utilizing public National IPA Technology Solutions Contract No. 2018011-01 with CDW Government, LLC, an authorized distributor, and waiving competitive bidding as it is advantageous to the city, the upon such costs having been approved by the Chief of Police.




