

**RESOLUTION NO. 2018-067**

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE USE OF \$427,000 OF HOME INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIPS (HOME) PROGRAM FUNDS AWARDED TO THE CITY BY THE U.S. DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (HUD) FOR RENTAL HOUSING REHABILITATION FOR TWO (2) CITY-OWNED ELDERLY HOUSING BUILDINGS CONTAINING A TOTAL OF TWENTY-NINE (29) UNITS OF ELDERLY-OCCUPIED AFFORDABLE HOUSING LOCATED AT 70 EAST 10 STREET AND 55 EAST 9 STREET; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, the City of Hialeah is an entitlement community and receives an annual allocation of funds from the United States Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) under the Community Planning and Development (CPD) Entitlement programs, including the HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME) Program; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Hialeah wishes to utilize \$427,000 in HOME Program funds awarded to the City by U.S. HUD to fund a rental housing rehabilitation project, an eligible HOME Program activity pursuant to the U.S. Code of Federal Regulations Title 24 Part 92, for the renovation of a city-owned elderly housing community, in accordance with the budget attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit 1; and

**WHEREAS**, the property proposed to be rehabilitated with the HUD-awarded funds is located at 70 East 10<sup>th</sup> Street and 55 East 9<sup>th</sup> Street, and contains twenty-nine (29) units of elderly-occupied affordable housing in Hialeah, Florida; and

**WHEREAS**, these elderly housing buildings were constructed in 1994 and are in need of rehabilitation; and

**WHEREAS**, the rehabilitation project proposes to update the buildings' windows and doors to increase their energy efficiency and improve the buildings to withstand windstorms at a standard that satisfies current technical codes; and

**WHEREAS**, the City finds the authorization to utilize the HOME Program funds pursuant to the federally mandated regulations provided in U.S. 24 CFR 92 for rehabilitation of the elderly housing buildings to be beneficial to the safety and welfare of all current and future residents of the property.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

**Section 1:** The foregoing facts and recitations contained in the preamble to this resolution are hereby adopted and incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein.


**Section 2:** The City of Hialeah, Florida hereby authorizes the use of \$427,000 of HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME) Program grant funds awarded by the U.S. Department of Housing and Urban Development (HUD) in accordance with the budget attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit 1, for the rental housing rehabilitation of two (2) city-owned elderly housing buildings located at 70 East 10<sup>th</sup> Street and 55 East 9<sup>th</sup> Street.

**Section 3:** This resolution shall become effective when passed by the City Council and signed by the Mayor or at the next regularly scheduled City Council meeting, if the Mayor's signature is withheld or if the City Council overrides the Mayor's veto.


