

RESOLUTION NO. 2018-070

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE ACTION PLAN FOR FISCAL YEAR 2018-2019, ATTACHED AS EXHIBITS A, B, C, AND D, INCLUDING THE BUDGET ALLOCATIONS AND SELECTED PROGRAMS FUNDED BY COMMUNITY DEVELOPMENT BLOCK GRANT FUNDS (CDBG), HOME INVESTMENT PARTNERSHIP FUNDS (HOME), AND EMERGENCY SOLUTIONS GRANT FUNDS (ESG), AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, TO SUBMIT THE ACTION PLAN TO THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF HOUSING AND URBAN DEVELOPMENT (HUD), AND TO EXECUTE ANY AND ALL AGREEMENTS, CERTIFICATIONS AND ASSURANCES IN FURTHERANCE OF THE PROGRAMS IN THE ACTION PLAN IN ACCORDANCE WITH FEDERAL HUD REGULATIONS.

WHEREAS, in order for the City to receive federal funds for the next fiscal year for the HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME), the Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) and the Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) programs, the City is required to submit an Action Plan which describes the activities to be undertaken for Fiscal Year 2018 (October 1, 2018 to September 30, 2019).

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

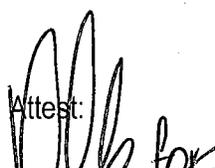
Section 1: The City of Hialeah Action Plan for Fiscal Year 2018-19 attached as Exhibits A, B, C and D is hereby approved.

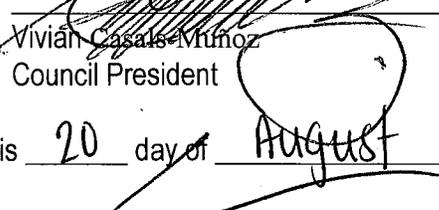

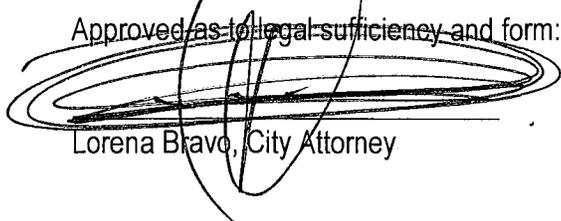
