

ORDINANCE NO. 2018-050

ORDINANCE APPROVING A FINAL PLAT OF ADIS SUBDIVISION; ACCEPTING ALL DEDICATION OF AVENUES, STREETS, ROADS OR OTHER PUBLIC WAYS, TOGETHER WITH ALL EXISTING AND FUTURE PLANTING OF TREES; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING PENALTIES FOR VIOLATION HEREOF; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE. **PROPERTY LOCATED AT 491 EAST 11 STREET, HIALEAH, FLORIDA.**

WHEREAS, the Planning and Zoning Board at its meeting of May 9, 2018, recommended approval of this ordinance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The final plat of Adis Subdivision, submitted by Bernardino N. Rodriguez and Adis Rodriguez, his wife, is hereby accepted. Property located at 491 East 11 Street, Hialeah, Florida, Zoned R-2 (One and Two Family Residential District), classified under the Future Land Use Map as Low Density Residential and legally described as follows:

Lots 16 and 17 and the East ½ of Lot 18, Block E6, 8th Addition to Hialeah, according to the Plat thereof as recorded in Plat Book 9, Page 11, of the Public Records of Miami-Dade County, Florida.

Section 2: All dedication of avenues or other public ways together with all existing and future planting, trees, shrubbery and fire hydrants thereon are hereby accepted.

Section 3: **Repeal of Ordinances in Conflict.**

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 4: Penalties.

Every person violating any provision of the Code or any ordinance, rule or regulation adopted or issued in pursuance thereof shall be assessed a civil penalty not to exceed \$500.00 within the discretion of the court or administrative tribunal having jurisdiction. Each act of violation and each day upon which any such violation shall occur shall constitute a separate offense. In addition to the penalty prescribed above, the city may pursue other remedies such as abatement of nuisance, injunctive relief, administrative adjudication and revocation of licenses or permits.

Section 5: Severability Clause.

If any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this ordinance shall be declared invalid or unconstitutional by the judgment or decree of a court of competent jurisdiction, such invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs or section of this ordinance.

Section 6: Effective Date.

This ordinance shall become effective when passed by the City Council of the City of Hialeah, Florida, and signed by the Mayor of the City of Hialeah, Florida.


