

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE TOTALING AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$2,521.08 FROM THE LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUND - STATE, TO PURCHASE THREE (3) COMPUTERS AND RELATED ACCESSORIES FROM TECH DEPOT AND PCMG, INC., THE LOWEST QUOTED VENDORS, UPON SUCH COSTS HAVING BEEN APPROVED BY THE CHIEF OF POLICE.

**WHEREAS**, the Hialeah Police Department Traffic Homicide Unit's mission is to respond to traffic related crashes wherein death or serious-bodily injury occurred; and

**WHEREAS**, the City of Hialeah Police Department's Traffic Homicide Unit and Crime Scene Unit respond to many scenes in which the investigations call for complex accident reconstruction; and

**WHEREAS**, specific software programs are necessary to conduct traffic related investigations and accident reconstruction;

**WHEREAS**, the current computers utilized by the Hialeah Police Department are not compatible with this specific software; and

**WHEREAS**, it is necessary for the Hialeah Police Department to work with the Information Technology Department to supply the necessary and specific computers and accessories in order for the Traffic Homicide Unit and Crime Scene Unit to conduct their technical investigations; and

**WHEREAS**, the funds to cover these necessary and legitimate expenses are available in the Law Enforcement Trust Fund -State; and

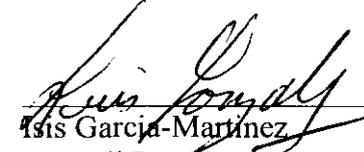
**WHEREAS**, the Chief of Police has recommended adoption of this resolution and determined that the proposed expenditure complies with the Florida Contraband Forfeiture Act, Section 932.7055, *Florida Statutes*.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

**Section 1.** The Mayor and the City Council of the City of Hialeah, Florida, approve the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$2,521.08 from the Law Enforcement Trust Fund – *State*, to purchase three (3) computers and related accessories from Tech Depot

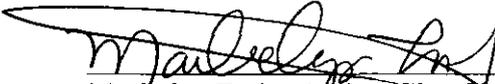
and PCMG, Inc., the lowest quoted vendors, upon such costs having been approved by the Chief of Police.

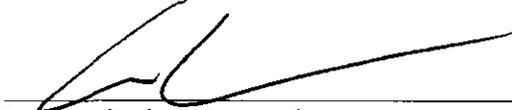

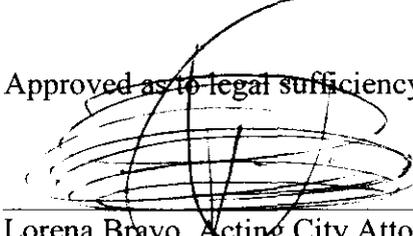
