

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE TOTALING AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$9,199.78 FROM THE LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUND - *FEDERAL*, TO PURCHASE THE PEN LINK TELECOMMUNICATION INTELLIGENCE & ANALYSIS SOFTWARE PACKAGE FROM PENLINK, A *SOLE SOURCE* VENDOR, UPON SUCH COSTS HAVING BEEN APPROVED BY THE CHIEF OF POLICE.

WHEREAS, the Hialeah Police Department investigates thousands of forcible felonies a year committed by offenders who attempt to have either their crime(s) or their whereabouts remain undetected;

WHEREAS, PenLink is a company that produces data intercept and surveillance equipment and software; and

WHEREAS, the PenLink software package will aid the Hialeah Police Department with intelligence gathering and live collection of investigative information as well as provide powerful reporting and analytical tools;

WHEREAS, the Hialeah Police Department is requesting authorization to purchase the PenLink Telecommunication Intelligence and Analysis Software package from PenLink, a *sole source* vendor, for a total expenditure not to exceed \$9,199.78; and

WHEREAS, the funds to cover these necessary and legitimate expenses are available in the Law Enforcement Trust Fund - *Federal*; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has recommended adoption of this resolution and determined that the proposed expenditure complies with the provisions of the *Guide To Equitable Sharing* and all applicable statutes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. The Mayor and the City Council of the City of Hialeah, Florida, approve the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$9,199.78, from the Law Enforcement Trust Fund

-Federal, to purchase the PenLink Telecommunication Intelligence and Analysis Software package from PenLink, a *sole source* vendor, upon such costs having been approved by the Chief of Police.

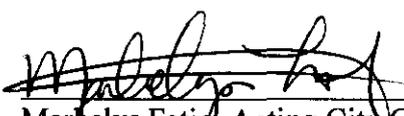

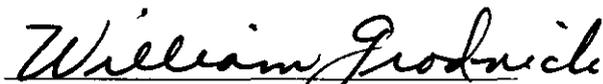
