RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA RE-NAMING THE CITY ELDERLY AFFORDABLE HOUSING BUILDING LOCATED AT 695 WEST 2 AVENUE, FORMERLY KNOWN AS ANGELA GARDENS TO "THE GARDENS," WITH THE COST OF SIGNAGE TO BE PAID BY THE CITY.


WHEREAS, the City Council recently approved Resolution No. 2014-6, to remove the name "Angela Gardens" from the City elderly affordable housing building located at 695 West 2 Avenue, formerly located 695 West 2 Avenue; and

WHEREAS, on February 3, 2014, the Hialeah Historic Preservation Board recommended to re-name the building "The Gardens," with the cost of signage to be paid by the City.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. The City elderly affordable housing building located at 695 West 2 Avenue, formerly known as Angela Gardens, is hereby re-named "The Gardens," and shall be known as such from this day forward, with the cost of signage to be paid by the City.




