RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA ACCEPTING THE GRANT AWARD FROM THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY DEPARTMENT OF CULTURAL AFFAIRS UNDER THE TARGETED INITIATIVES GRANTS PROGRAM AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND THE ACTING CITY CLERK, AS ATTESTING WITNESS, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY, TO ENTER INTO A GRANT AGREEMENT COMMENCING ON OCTOBER 1, 2013 AND ENDING SEPTEMBER 30, 2014 IN FURTHERANCE THEREOF, IN A FORM ACCEPTABLE TO THE CITY ATTORNEY.

WHEREAS, the Miami-Dade Department of Cultural Affairs, under its Targeted Initiatives Grants Program, notified the City of Hialeah of a grant awarded to the City in the amount of \$30,000 to support the City's Art on Palm, July 4th and Hispanic Heritage Month Series events.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:


Section 1: The foregoing facts and recitations contained in the preamble to this resolution are hereby incorporated and adopted by reference as if fully set forth herein.

form acceptable to the City Attorney.




