

RESOLUTION NO. 2014-08

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA REPEALING AND RESCINDING HIALEAH, FLA., RESOLUTION 97-21 (MAR. 24, 1997).

WHEREAS, having adopted Hialeah, Fla., Ordinance 13-83 (Dec. 2, 2013), which prohibits the naming of City properties after elected officials or relatives during the lifetime of elected officials, the City Council has reexamined the naming of existing properties in light of the new change to the Hialeah Code; and


WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that the 2.12-acre municipal park located between Hialeah/Hialeah Gardens Boulevard, on the west, and West 33 Avenue, on the east, and between West 78 Street, if extended, and West 79 Street, if extended, within Hialeah, should not retain its current name.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The findings and recitations contained in preamble to this resolution are hereby incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein.

Section 2: The City Council of Hialeah, Florida hereby repeals and rescinds Hialeah, Fla., Resolution 97-21 (Mar. 24, 1997) in its entirety.




