RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA REPEALING AND RESCINDING HIALEAH, FLA., RESOLUTION 05-141 (DEC. 14, 2005).

WHEREAS, having adopted Hialeah, Fla., Ordinance 13-83 (Dec. 2, 2013), which prohibits the naming of City properties after elected officials or relatives during the lifetime of elected officials, the City Council has reexamined the naming of existing properties in light of the new change to the Hialeah Code; and


WHEREAS, the City Council has determined that Hialeah City Hall located at 501 Palm Avenue should not retain the current name.

Section 2: The City Council of Hialeah, Florida hereby repeals and rescinds Hialeah, Fla., Resolution 05-141 (Dec. 14, 2005) in its entirety.




