

**RESOLUTION NO. 13-17**

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA APPROVING THE CO-DESIGNATION OF A PORTION OF WEST 1<sup>ST</sup> AVENUE, FROM WEST 5<sup>TH</sup> STREET TO WEST 6<sup>TH</sup> STREET, HIALEAH, FLORIDA, AS "WOMAN'S CLUB AVENUE", IN RECOGNITION OF THE GFWC WOMAN'S CLUB OF HIALEAH'S DEDICATION TO THE BETTERMENT OF THE COMMUNITY THROUGH ITS VOLUNTEER SERVICES, WITH THE COST OF SIGNAGE TO BE PAID BY THE CITY.

**WHEREAS**, the co-designation of that portion of West 1<sup>st</sup> Avenue, from West 5<sup>th</sup> Street to West 6<sup>th</sup> Street, Hialeah, Florida, as "WOMAN'S CLUB AVENUE", presently unnamed, is in recognition of the dedication of the GFWC Woman's Club of Hialeah's dedication to the betterment of the community through its volunteer services, with the cost of signage to be paid by the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the General Federation of Women's Clubs (GFWC) has been a unifying force, bringing together local women's clubs from around the country and throughout the world; and

**WHEREAS**, although there is considerable diversity in the ages, interests, and experiences of GFWC clubwomen, all are united by a dedication to community improvement through volunteer service; and

**WHEREAS**, accomplishments during GFWC's first century include establishing 75 percent of the country's public libraries, developing kindergartens in the public schools, and working for food and drug regulation; and

**WHEREAS**, during its second century, the GFWC has pledged to maintain its commitment to working for a better world and, with its "Unity in Diversity" motto and a strong umbrella of programs that clubs may adapt to suit the needs of their communities, GFWC encourages the flexibility that has enabled it to expand its reach in a rapidly changing society; and


**WHEREAS**, the GFWC Woman's Club of Hialeah has exemplified the mission and values of the GFWC by providing opportunities for education, leadership training, and community service to both members and non-members alike on local, state, national, and global levels; and

**WHEREAS**, the Historic Preservation Board recommended approval of this resolution on March 5, 2013.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:




