
RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND/OR HIS DESIGNEE TO RECEIVE AN AWARD, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$500,000.00, AND TO EXECUTE ANY AND ALL DOCUMENTS, FROM THE STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ELDER AFFAIRS, UNDER THE SENIOR CENTER FIXED CAPITAL OUTLAY STATE GRANTS AND AIDS, FOR THE CONSTRUCTION OF A MULTI-PURPOSE ADULT CENTER TO BE LOCATED WITHIN THE PREMISES OF THE 300 UNIT ELDERLY HOUSINGPROJECT (2659 WEST OKEECHOBEE ROAD).

WHEREAS, the City of Hialeah received an award in the amount of \$500,000.00 from the State of Florida Department of Elder Affairs, under the Senior Center Fixed Capital Outlay State Grants and Aids for the construction of a multi-purpose adult center to be located within the 300 Unit Elderly Housing Project for the provision of recreational and social activities, including hot meals, arts and crafts, ceramics, exercise classes, nutritional education as well as social events year-round to elderly tenants.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:






