

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE TOTALING AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$162,564.24 FROM THE LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUND – *FEDERAL*, AS FOLLOWS: \$147,216.00 FOR THE PURCHASE OF SIX 2013 FORD INTERCEPTOR UTILITY (K7A) POLICE VEHICLES FROM DON REID FORD, UTILIZING THE PRICING ESTABLISHED BY A COMPETITIVE BID FROM THE FLORIDA SHERIFF'S ASSOCIATION, AND EMERGENCY EQUIPMENT WITH INSTALLATION FROM RAINBOW WINDOW TINTING INC. FOR \$15,348.24 UPON SUCH COSTS HAVING BEEN APPROVED BY THE CHIEF OF POLICE.

WHEREAS, the Hialeah Police Department desires that six 2013 Ford Interceptor Utility (K7A) police vehicles be purchased from Don Reid Ford through the utilization of pricing established by a competitive bid from the Florida Sheriff's Association; and

WHEREAS the Hialeah Police Department further desires the purchase of emergency equipment and installation by Rainbow Window Tinting Inc: and

WHEREAS, in an effort to prepare itself for hurricanes, flooding and special weather events these six (6) Ford Interceptor Utility vehicles are needed; and

WHEREAS, in order to properly serve the community, it is necessary to purchase fully-equipped marked utility vehicles; and

WHEREAS, the funds to cover these necessary and legitimate expenses are available in the Law Enforcement Trust Fund - *Federal*; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police has recommended adoption of this resolution and determined that the proposed expenditure complies with *Guide To Equitable Sharing* and all applicable statutes; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1. The Mayor and the City Council of the City of Hialeah, Florida, approve the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$162,564.24 from the Law Enforcement

Trust Fund – *Federal*, as follows: \$147,216.00 for the purchase of six 2013 Ford Interceptor Utility (K7A) police vehicles from Don Reid Ford utilizing the pricing from a competitive bid from the Florida Sheriff's Association and emergency equipment with installation from Rainbow Window Tinting Inc. for the cost of \$15,348.24, upon such costs having been approved by the Chief of Police.




