

RESOLUTION NO. 13-29

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA APPROVING THE CO-DESIGNATION OF A PORTION OF WEST 78TH STREET, FROM WEST 7TH AVENUE TO WEST 8TH AVENUE, HIALEAH, FLORIDA, AS "REVEREND JOSE LUIS PANIAGUA WAY", IN RECOGNITION OF REVEREND PANIAGUA'S DEVOTION AND DEDICATION TO THE BETTERMENT OF HIS COMMUNITY, WITH THE COST OF SIGNAGE TO BE PAID BY THE APPLICANT.

WHEREAS, the co-designation of that portion of West 78th Street, from West 7th Avenue to West 8th Avenue, Hialeah, Florida, as "REVEREND JOSE LUIS PANIAGUA WAY", presently unnamed, is in recognition of Reverend Paniagua's devotion and dedication to the betterment of his community, with the cost of signage to be paid by the applicant; and

WHEREAS, Reverend Paniagua came to Miami-Dade County in 1964, and served the immigrant community from Delray Beach to Pompano Beach for five years; and

WHEREAS, Reverend Paniagua later served as a priest at Corpus Christi Catholic Church and St. Peter and Paul Catholic Church; and

WHEREAS, in 1988, he became the Pastor of St. Benedict Catholic Church in Hialeah, serving his community until the present time; and

WHEREAS, in addition to his religious work, Reverend Paniagua also served the community of Hialeah as a Commissioner of the Housing Authority from 2005 to 2008; and

WHEREAS, the Historic Preservation Board recommended approval of this resolution on April 1, 2013.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The portion of West 78th Street, from West 7th Avenue to West 8th Avenue, Hialeah, Florida, presently unnamed, is hereby co-designated as "REVEREND

JOSE LUIS PANIAGUA WAY", and shall be known as such from this day forward, with the costs of signage to be paid by the applicant.




