RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA ENDORSING ALL EFFORTS OF THE MIAMI-DADE COUNTY PROPERTY APPRAISER TO INVESTIGATE AND IDENTIFY HOMESTEAD EXEMPTION FRAUD IN ORDER TO PRESERVE AD VALOREM TAX REVENUES THAT ARE DUE AND OWING TO THE CITY.


WHEREAS, the City fully supports all efforts to investigate and identify homestead exemption fraud through the Miami-Dade County Property Appraiser's Office.

Section 1: The findings and recitations contained in preamble to this resolution are hereby incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein.






