

RESOLUTION NO. 2013-83

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND/OR HIS DESIGNEE TO RECEIVE AN AWARD, IN THE AMOUNT OF \$500,000.00, AND TO EXECUTE ANY AND ALL DOCUMENTS, FROM THE STATE OF FLORIDA DEPARTMENT OF ELDER AFFAIRS, UNDER THE ALLIANCE FOR AGING, INC., FOR THE PROVISION OF ADDITIONAL CONGREGATE AND HOMEBOUND DELIVERED MEALS THROUGHOUT THE CITY, FOR THE PERIOD JULY 1, 2013 TO JUNE 30, 2014, AND FURTHER AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA TO EXECUTE AN AGREEMENT WITH THE HIALEAH HOUSING AUTHORITY FOR THE PROVISION OF THESE SERVICES.

WHEREAS, the City of Hialeah received an award in the amount of \$500,000.00 from the State of Florida Department of Elder Affairs, under the Alliance for Aging, Inc., for the provision of additional congregate and homebound delivered meals throughout the City, for the period July 1, 2013 to June 30, 2014


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The Mayor and City Council authorize the receipt of \$500,000.00 from the State of Florida Department of Elder Affairs, under the Alliance for Aging, Inc., for the provision of additional congregate and homebound delivered meals throughout the City, for the period July 1, 2013 to June 30, 2014.

Section 2: The Mayor and/or his designee are hereby authorized to execute any and all documents, from the State of Florida Department of Elder Affairs, under the Alliance for Aging, Inc., to receive these funds.

Section 3: The Mayor and/or his designee is further authorized to enter into an agreement with the Hialeah Housing Authority for the provision of these services.




