

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE ON BEHALF OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, TO ENTER INTO AN AGREEMENT WITH FRANCO GOVERNMENT RELATIONS, INC., IN THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$50,000.00, PAYABLE IN EQUAL MONTHLY INSTALLMENTS OF \$4,166.67 AS PROVIDED BY AGREEMENT, FOR ONE YEAR, COMMENCING ON JULY 1, 2013 AND ENDING ON JUNE 30, 2014, TO ASSIST THE CITY IN IDENTIFYING AND SECURING ADDITIONAL FEDERAL RESOURCES, IN A FORM ACCEPTABLE TO THE CITY ATTORNEY.


WHEREAS, they have an exceptional network of relationships with lawmakers and their staff as well as hands on experience in influencing federal policy and legislation; and






