

ORDINANCE NO. 2018-066

ORDINANCE OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA AMENDING CHAPTER 2, "ADMINISTRATION", ARTICLE II, ENTITLED "DEPARTMENTS, OFFICES AND DIVISIONS", DIVISION 8 ENTITLED "FINANCE DEPARTMENT, §§2-237; AMENDING DIVISION 9. ENTITLED "OFFICE OF MANAGEMENT AND BUDGET, §§2-267, TO ADD THE PURCHASING DEPARTMENT TO THE DIVISION OF FINANCE AND REMOVING IT FROM THE DIVISION OF THE OFFICE OF MANAGEMENT AND BUDGET; REPEALING ALL ORDINANCES OR PARTS OF ORDINANCES IN CONFLICT HEREWITH; PROVIDING FOR A SEVERABILITY CLAUSE; PROVIDING FOR INCLUSION IN CODE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the City of Hialeah moved the Purchasing Department under the direction of the Finance Department on February 11, 2014 by Ordinance No. 2014-10.

WHEREAS, Chapter 2, "Administration", Article II entitled "Departments, Offices and Divisions", Division 8 entitled "Finance Department §§ 2-237 and Division 9 entitled "Office of Management and Budget" §§ 267 require updating as a result of the prior changes.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: Chapter 2 entitled "Administration", Article II entitled "Departments, Offices and Divisions" is hereby amended as follows:

Chapter 2

ADMINISTRATION

* * *

**ARTICLE II. – DEPARTMENTS, OFFICES AND
DIVISIONS**

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DIVISION 8. – FINANCE DEPARTMENT

* * *

Sec. 2-237. – Finance director.

The finance director shall be the principal financial officer of the city and the administrative head of the finance department. Subject to the supervision of the mayor, the finance director shall administer the affairs of the department and supervise the purchasing division and retirement division. In addition to the general responsibilities, the director shall have the following enumerated powers and duties:

- (1) Supervise the disbursement and expenditures of all funds to ensure that budget appropriations are not exceeded.

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DIVISION 9. – OFFICE OF MANAGEMENT AND BUDGET

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Sec. 2-267. – Office of Management and Budget Director.

Subject to the supervision of the mayor, the director of the office of management and budget shall be the administrative head of the office of management and budget. The director shall administer the affairs of the department ~~and supervise the purchasing division~~. The director shall provide budgetary projections and make recommendations to the mayor and to the city council on all issues related to the municipal budget, cost effectiveness, productivity and efficiency.

Section 2: Repeal of Ordinances in Conflict.

All ordinances or parts of ordinances in conflict herewith are hereby repealed to the extent of such conflict.

Section 3: Severability Clause.

If any phrase, clause, sentence, paragraph or section of this ordinance shall be declared invalid or unconstitutional by the judgment or decree of a court of competent jurisdiction, such

invalidity or unconstitutionality shall not affect any of the remaining phrases, clauses, sentences, paragraphs or sections of this ordinance.

Section 4: Inclusion in Code. The provisions of this Ordinance shall be included and incorporated in the Code of Ordinances of the City of Hialeah, as an addition or amendment thereto, and the sections of this ordinance shall be renumbered to conform to the uniform numbering system of the Code.

Section 5: Effective Date.

This ordinance shall become effective when passed by the City Council and signed by the Mayor or at the next regularly scheduled City Council meeting, if the Mayor's signature is withheld or if the City Council overrides the Mayor's veto.






