RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA APPROVING THE HIALEAH PUBLIC LIBRARIES' LONG RANGE PLAN FOR YEARS 2018-2021 FOR SUBMITTAL TO THE STATE LIBRARY OF THE STATE OF FLORIDA IN ORDER TO MAINTAIN ELIGIBILITY AS A RECIPIENT OF STATE AND FEDERAL FUNDS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the State Aid to Libraries Program is to assist local governments in maintaining and developing free professional library services and in particular, providing equal access to free public library services to all residents of the service areas of participating governments, coordinating library service throughout the service area and providing consistent level of operation, maintenance and development of library services; and

WHEREAS, in order to fulfill the requirements of the State Aid to Libraries Program and applicable federal grant programs, the City of Hialeah Public Libraries developed a Long Range Plan.


NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The Mayor and the City Council of the City of Hialeah, Florida hereby approve Long Range Plan for years 2018-2021 for submittal to the State Library of the State of Florida in order to maintain eligibility as a recipient of state and federal funds.

Section 2: **Effective Date.** This resolution shall become effective when passed by the City Council of the City of Hialeah, Florida, upon signature of the Mayor

of the City of Hialeah or at the next regularly scheduled City Council meeting if the Mayor's signature is withheld or if the City Council overrides the Mayor's veto.




