

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-016

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, TO EXTEND SERVICES WITH THE PRIOR COMPETITIVELY BID AWARD FOR THREE ADDITIONAL YEARS WITH NO COST INCREASE AND AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR AND CITY CLERK, ON BEHALF OF THE CITY, TO ENTER INTO A PROFESSIONAL SERVICES AGREEMENT WITH UNITED HEALTHCARE, INC., WHICH PROCESSES GROUP HEALTH CLAIMS FOR THE CITY, FOR A TERM OF THREE ADDITIONAL YEARS FOR CALENDAR YEARS 2020, 2021, AND 2022 FOR A FIXED MONTHLY RATE OF \$32.77 FOR EACH EMPLOYEE/ RETIRED EMPLOYEE, FOR AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$750,000.00 EACH YEAR IN A FORM ACCEPTABLE TO THE CITY ATTORNEY.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Hialeah, Fla., Resolution 08-153 (Oct. 28, 2008), the City of Hialeah entered into a three-year agreement with United Healthcare, Inc. and United Healthcare, Inc. has satisfactorily performed thereunder; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Hialeah, Fla., Resolution 11-39 (May 5, 2011), the City of Hialeah renewed its professional services agreement with United Healthcare, Inc. for calendar years 2012 and 2013, with a rate reduction from \$35.19 per employee/retiree per month to \$32.77 per employee/per month; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Hialeah, Fla., Resolution 13-65 (Aug. 13, 2013), the City of Hialeah renewed its professional services agreement with United Healthcare, Inc. for calendar years 2014, 2015, and 2016 with no rate increase and agreed to include KAPHS 2.0 clinic program at no additional cost; and

WHEREAS, pursuant to Hialeah, Fla., Resolution 16-40 (Apr. 26, 2016), the City of Hialeah renewed its professional services agreement with United Healthcare, Inc. for calendar years 2017, 2018, and 2019, with no rate increase; and

WHEREAS, the City of Hialeah finds that it is in its best interest to renew its professional services agreement with United Healthcare, Inc. for calendar years 2020, 2021, and 2022 with no cost increase; and

WHEREAS, it is advantageous to the City to extend the prior competitively bid award with no cost increase since services will continue and the cost savings with United Healthcare have been significant.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The Mayor and the City Council of the City of Hialeah, Florida hereby extend services with the prior competitively bid award for three additional years with no cost increase and authorizing the Mayor and City Clerk, on behalf of the City, to enter into a professional services agreement with United Healthcare, Inc., which processes group health claims for the city, for a term of three additional years for calendar years 2020, 2021, and 2022 for a fixed monthly rate of \$32.77 for each employee/ retired employee, for an amount not to exceed \$750,000.00 each year in a form acceptable to the City Attorney.




