With this issue of the Hialeah Update I would like to share with you some of the things we are doing around the “City of Progress”. I look forward to seeing all of you around our city.

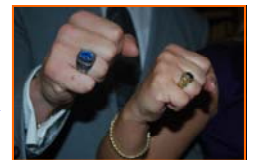
