PLAN SUMMARY:

The City of Hialeah Fiscal Year 2010 Action Plan includes the following federal programs: Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) \$4,547,992.00, Emergency Shelter Grant (ESG) \$184,969.00, and HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME) \$2,297,226.00. The one-year Action Plan describes the City's distribution of funds to carry out activities using funds that are expected to be received under formula program allocations. The activities under these programs include public facilities and improvements, public services, housing, and economic development.
