



## CITY OF HIALEAH 5-YEAR CONSOLIDATED PLAN NOTICE OF 2<sup>nd</sup> PUBLIC HEARING

The City of Hialeah announces a second public hearing to which all interested parties are invited.

**PURPOSE:** To obtain public comments on the proposed 5-Year Consolidated Plan.

**PLAN SUMMARY:**

The Consolidated Plan (5-Year Plan) is the planning and application document for the following federal programs: Community Development Block Grant (CDBG), Emergency Shelter Grant (ESG), and Home Investment Partnership (HOME). It covers a five-year period beginning October 1, 2010 through September 30, 2015. The Plan contains specific elements including: an assessment of housing and homeless needs for the ensuing 5-year period; Hialeah's housing data; a discussion of Hialeah's strategies, priority needs and objectives for housing and community development activities; and a One-Year Action Plan that describes the City distribution of funds to carry out activities using funds that are expected to be received under formula allocations.

The 5-Year Consolidated Plan and the 1-Year Action Plan will be presented for approval at the regular City Council meeting scheduled for Tuesday, August 10, 2010, at 7:00 p.m. at the City of Hialeah City Hall Council Chambers, 501 Palm Avenue, 3<sup>rd</sup> Floor. Final comments will be accepted at the hearing.
