Ribbon Cutting Ceremony to Welcome Resident into Newly Reconstructed Home

Hialeah, Florida – On Tuesday, December 20, 2011, a long-time Hialeah resident will be officially welcomed into their newly rebuilt home by Mayor Carlos Hernandez and members of the Hialeah City Council. Ms. Marion Christie said, “This program has helped me so much. I am very happy with my new home.”

The house, located at 75 East 63rd Street, was rebuilt under the City's Demolition and Reconstruction Program, which provides assistance to low income families by replacing homes on the existing lots. These properties are beyond rehabilitation and are usually unsafe structures. Funds are provided by the State of Florida SHIP Program or Federal CDBG Funds.

The objective of the program is to correct neighborhood health and safety hazards by rebuilding homes, allowing families to remain in their own neighborhood. Over the years the City of Hialeah has completed over 60 home replacements through this program, greatly improving and stabilizing many neighborhoods as a result.
