This is to give notice that the City of Hialeah intends to undertake a project funded by the U. S. Department of Housing and Urban Development, referred to as the **CDBG Roadway Improvement Program** under HUD grant contract number E-15-MC-12-0008. The Project consists of complete right-of-way reconstruction in an area approximately bounded on the north by West 33<sup>rd</sup> Street, on the south by West 30<sup>th</sup> Street, on the east by West 8<sup>th</sup> Avenue and on the west by West 12<sup>th</sup> Avenue. Improvements will include new drainage, roadway asphalt surface, lighting, concrete sidewalk and driveway aprons, concrete curb & gutter and appropriate traffic signage. This is a fully developed residential area, and much of the work will replace existing facilities. The entire potential project area is approximately 2,931,000 square feet.

The Project construction will be undertaken in the 100-year floodplain/wetland. The City of Hialeah is conducting an evaluation as required by Executive Orders 11988 and 11990, in accordance with HUD regulations at 24 CFR 55.20 Subpart C Procedures for Making Determinations on Floodplain Management, to determine the potential affect that the proposed activity in the floodplain will have on the natural and human environment. The City is interested in alternatives and public perceptions of possible adverse impacts that could result from the project, as well as potential mitigation measures.
