RESOLUTION OF THE HISTORIC PRESERVATION BOARD OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, NAMING THE HIGH SCHOOL BASEBALL FIELD AT SLADE PARK, LOCATED AT 2501 WEST 74 STREET, IN HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THE "JORGE RAMOS FIELD AT CARL F. SLADE PARK."

**WHEREAS**, the Historic Preservation Board at its meeting on March 1, 2017 recommended that the High School Baseball Field at Slade Park be named as the Jorge Ramos Field;

**WHEREAS**, Jorge Ramos was a resident of Hialeah, a loving father and husband, and was also the founding father of the City of Hialeah Educational Academy Baseball Program and, under his vision, leadership, and guidance it grew into a highly competitive team throughout the City.




