RESOLUTION OF THE HIALEAH HISTORIC PRESERVATION BOARD RECOMMENDING THE DESIGNATION OF WEST 25th STREET FROM WEST 4th AVENUE TO WEST 8th AVENUE HIALEAH, FLORIDA, AS "MICHAEL WRIGHT WAY", IN HONOR OF THE OUTSTANDING SERVICE OF MICHAEL WRIGHT, THE FIRST AFRICAN AMERICAN FIREFIGHTER IN THE CITY OF HIALEAH, WITH THE COST OF SIGNAGE TO BE PAID BY THE CITY.

WHEREAS, the designation of West 25th Street from West 4th Avenue To West 8th Avenue Hialeah, Florida, as "Michael Wright Way", is in honor of the outstanding service of Michael Wright, the first African American firefighter in the City of Hialeah, and who after twenty-five years of outstanding service retired as a Lieutenant; and

WHEREAS, Michael Wright was a resident of Hialeah, was a leader in the community, and a mentor to his fellow fire fighters who remained an inspiration to others during trying times in his life, including his own battle with cancer.


