

RESOLUTION NO. 14-02

RESOLUTION OF THE HIALEAH HISTORIC PRESERVATION BOARD RENAMING THE CITY PARK LOCATED AT 7900 WEST 32 AVENUE, HIALEAH, FLORIDA, FORMERLY KNOWN AS CASAS PARK, AS "VETERANS PARK," IN RECOGNITION AND COMMEMORATION OF THE BRAVE MEN AND WOMEN WHO HAVE SERVED IN THE U.S. ARMED FORCES AND HAVE SELFLESSLY SACRIFICED TO FIGHT FOR OUR FREEDOM, WITH THE COST OF SIGNAGE TO BE PAID BY THE CITY.

**WHEREAS**, the City Council recently approved Resolution No. 2014-8, to remove the name "Casas Park" from the City park currently located at 7900 West 32 Avenue; and

**WHEREAS**, on February 3, 2014, the Hialeah Historic Preservation Board recommended to re-name the park "Veterans Park," with the cost of signage to be paid by the City; and

**WHEREAS**, the park is currently enjoyed by Hialeah residents and non-residents alike for its sports and recreation facilities, walking trails, green areas, and other amenities; and


**WHEREAS**, the re-naming of the park to Veterans Park is in recognition and commemoration of the brave men and women who have served in the U.S. Armed Forces and have selflessly sacrificed to fight for our freedom.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HIALEAH HISTORIC PRESERVATION BOARD THAT:


