

**RESOLUTION NO. 2022-003**

RESOLUTION OF THE HIALEAH HISTORIC PRESERVATION BOARD RECOMMENDING RE-NAMING TRIANGLE PARK, LOCATED AT 290 PALM AVENUE TO "VETERAN'S PARK" IN HONOR OF THE MEN AND WOMEN WHO SERVE OR HAVE SERVED IN THE UNITED STATES ARMED FORCES, WITH THE COST OF SIGNAGE TO BE PAID BY THE CITY; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, roughly 18 million living American's have served in the United States Armed Forces in conflicts ranging from the World Wars to the War on Terror; and


**WHEREAS**, veterans fight to protect and defend freedom and democracy when tyranny threatens the World; and

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE HIALEAH HISTORIC PRESERVATION BOARD THAT:


