RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO ACCEPT A DIRECT AWARD FROM THE UNITED STATES DEPARTMENT OF JUSTICE, BUREAU OF JUSTICE ASSISTANCE, EDWARD BYRNE MEMORIAL JUSTICE ASSISTANCE GRANT PROGRAM, FOR THE TOTAL AMOUNT OF \$43,755.00, FOR THE PROCUREMENT OF POLICE PATROL VEHICLES AND IN COMPLIANCE WITH THE FBI NATIONAL INCIDENT-BASED REPORTING SYSTEM (NIBRS) PROJECT; APPROVING AND RATIFYING THE GRANT APPLICATION AND AGREEMENT A COPY OF WHICH IS ATTACHED HERETO AND MADE A PART HEREOF AS EXHIBIT "1" AND ALL ACTION TAKEN IN SUPPORT OF THE APPLICATION; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR HIS DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ALL NECESSARY DOCUMENTS IN FURTHERANCE THEREOF; AUTHORIZING THE ESTABLISHMENT OF A SEPARATE INTEREST BEARING TRUST ACCOUNT DESIGNATED FOR THIS PROGRAM; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, the City is eligible to receive a direct award in the amount of \$43,755.00 under the United States Department of Justice, Bureau of Assistance's Fiscal Year 2019 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program, for the procurement of police patrol vehicles.

**WHEREAS**, the City of Hialeah finds it in the best interest of the community to accept the grant award from United States Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

**Section 1:** The Mayor and City Council of the City of Hialeah, Florida hereby authorize the Mayor or his designee to accept a direct award from the United States Department of Justice, Bureau of Justice Assistance, under the Fiscal Year 2019 Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance Grant Program, for the total amount of \$43,755.00, for the procurement of police patrol vehicles and in compliance with the FBI National Incident-Based Reporting System (NIBRS) Project, approve and ratify the Grant Application, a copy of which is attached hereto and made a part hereof as Exhibit "1", and all action taken in support of the Grant Application,

and further authorize the Mayor or his designee to execute all necessary documents in furtherance thereof.

**Section 2:** The Mayor and the City Council of the City of Hialeah, Florida further authorize the establishment of a separate interest-bearing trust account designated for this program.




