

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-155

A RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING A "PIGGY BACK CONTRACT" PURSUANT TO HIALEAH CODE OF ORDINANCES § 2-818 AND AUTHORIZING THE CITY TO PURCHASE FROM ALAN JAY CHEVROLET-CADILLAC, INC., FIVE 2020 CHEVROLET COLORADO CREW CAB WORK TRUCKS, APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE NOT TO EXCEED \$121,693.10 FROM THE LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUND – *STATE/* CAPITAL OUTLAY VEHICLE ACCOUNT, SUCH COSTS HAVING BEEN APPROVED BY THE CHIEF OF POLICE.

WHEREAS; pursuant to City of Hialeah Code of Ordinances § 2-818 the City is authorized to piggyback and enter into contracts without competitive bidding by utilizing existing local, state or other governmental authorities that followed a competitive bidding procedure leading to the award of a contract; and

WHEREAS, The Florida Sheriffs Association & Florida Association of Counties issued a Request for Proposal No. FSA19-VEL27.0, dated May 18, 2019, entitled: "Pursuit, Administrative, and Other Vehicles", substantially similar to the RFP process used by the City in its procurement of goods and services; and

WHEREAS, Alan Jay Chevrolet-Cadillac, Inc., was awarded the contract to provide such services on October 1, 2019; and

WHEREAS, the funds to cover these necessary and legitimate expenses are available in the Law Enforcement Trust Fund – *State/Capital* Outlay – Vehicles.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The above recitals are true and correct and incorporated herein.

Section 2: The Mayor and the City Council of the City of Hialeah, Florida, approve the expenditure of an amount not to exceed \$121,693.10 from the Law Enforcement Trust Fund – *State/Capital* Outlay – Vehicles, to purchase five 2020 Chevrolet Colorado Crew Cab Work Trucks from Alan Jay Chevrolet-Cadillac, Inc., based on the competitively procured bid by the

Florida Sheriffs Association & Florida Association of Counties, such costs having been approved by the Chief of Police.

Section 3: Effective Date.


