

RESOLUTION NO. 2019-160

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH IN SUPPORT OF HOUSE BILL 829 BY THE FLORIDA LEGISLATURE PROHIBITING TOLLS AND EXPRESS LANES ON STATE ROAD 826 BY JULY 1, 2020.

WHEREAS, tolls are an economic stress on our working population that traverses State Road 826 regularly to get to and return from work; and

WHEREAS, express lanes have exacerbated congestion, rather than relieve it for our working population, as well as for our tourists, and residents at large.

THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:


Section 1. The foregoing facts and recitations contained in the preamble to this Resolution are hereby adopted and incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein.

Section 2. The City of Hialeah strongly supports House Bill 829 that shall prohibit tolls and express lanes on State Road 826 by July 1, 2020.


Section 3. The City Clerk is directed to send a certified copy of this Resolution to the Florida League of Cities, Miami-Dade League of Cities, the Clerk for the Senate and House of Representatives, and such other authorities as may be appropriate.

Section 4: This resolution shall become effective upon signature of the Mayor of the City of Hialeah, Florida or at the next regularly scheduled City Council meeting, if the Mayor's signature is withheld or if the City Council overrides the Mayor's veto.


