RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, AUTHORIZING THE HIALEAH FIRE RESCUE DEPARTMENT TO **PARTICIPATE** $\mathbf{I}\mathbf{N}$ INTERGOVERNMENTAL TRANSFERS WITH THE STATE OF FLORIDA AGENCY FOR HEALTH CARE ADMINISTRATION THE AND SUPPLEMENTAL PAYMENT PROGRAM FOR MEDICAID MANAGED CARE PATIENTS; AUTHORIZING THE TRANSFER OF AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$154,884.00 FOR FISCAL YEAR 2019-2020 TO THE AGENCY FOR HEALTH CARE ADMINISTRTION AS THE CITY'S SHARE OF THE STATE FUNDING REQUIREMENT; AUTHORIZING THE MAYOR OR MAYOR'S DESIGNEE TO EXECUTE ALL REQUIRED AGREEMENTS OR DOCUMENTS TO **PARTICIPATE** IN INTERGOVENMENTAL TRANSFERS AND THE SUPPLEMENTAL PAYMENT PROGRAM FOR MEDICAID MANAGED PATIENTS; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the State of Florida has created a supplemental payment program for Medicaid managed care patients who are transported to the hospital by public emergency medical transportation providers and has appropriated an additional \$50 million for this program; and

WHEREAS, by participating in the supplemental payment program for Medicaid managed care patients, the Hialeah Fire Rescue can substantially increase reimbursements for Medicaid managed care patient transports and provide better services to the community.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

Section 1: The foregoing facts and recitations contained in the preamble to this resolution are hereby adopted and incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein.

Section 2: The City of Hialeah, Florida hereby authorizes Hialeah Fire Rescue to participate in intergovernmental transfers with the State of Florida Agency for Health Care Administration and the supplemental payment program for Medicaid managed care patients.

Section 3: The City of Hialeah, Florida hereby authorizes the Mayor or Mayor's designee to execute all required agreements or documents to participate in intergovenmental transfers with the State of Florida Agency for Health Care Administration and the supplemental payment program for Medicaid managed patients.

Section 4: The City of Hialeah, Florida hereby authorizes the transfer of an amount not to exceed \$154,884.00 to the State of Florida Agency for Health Care Administration for Fiscal Year 2019-2020 as the City's share of the State funding requirement of the Medicaid managed care supplemental payment program.

<u>Section 5:</u> This resolution shall become effective when approved by majority vote of the City Council and signed by the Mayor or at the next regularly scheduled City Council meeting, if the Mayor's signature is withheld or if the City Council overrides the Mayor's veto.
