

**RESOLUTION NO. 2020-021**

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, DIRECTING THE CITY ATTORNEY TO REPORT TO THE CITY COUNCIL ON THE PROGRESS OF THE OBLIGATIONS ASSUMED BY THE CITY SPECIFICALLY TO ADDRESS UNAUTHORIZED MUNICIPAL APPROVALS IN THE CONSENT AGREEMENT BETWEEN THE CITY AND MIAMI-DADE COUNTY DERM TO ON A QUARTERLY BASIS BEGINNING IN MAY 2020 AND EVERY THREE MONTHS THEREAFTER, AT REGULARLY SCHEDULED MEETING OF THE COUNCIL, UNTIL THE TERM OF THE CONSENT AGREEMENT ENDS OR ALL OBLIGATIONS ARE MET; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, On January 28, 2020, the City Council adopted Hialeah, Fla. Resolution 2020-013 approving a consent agreement between Miami-Dade County DERM and the City to redress unauthorized municipal license approvals;

**WHEREAS**, as part of the obligations assumed by the City in the consent agreement, the City is required to: report all municipal approvals of business licenses and development permits; perform an expanded audit of the businesses issued unauthorized municipal licenses; and modify the City's existing intake systems or processes for license applications and development permits such that all submittals and applications which require DERM review and approval are in fact reviewed and approved by DERM prior to final approval by the City;


**WHEREAS**, receiving the reports achieves the Mayor's and Council's desire to be timely informed of the progress of the City's performance of its obligations to Miami-Dade County DERM under the consent agreement and allows the Council ample opportunity to consider any matters requiring Council's consent or approval related to the City's performance under the consent agreement;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

**Section 1:** The City Attorney is hereby directed to report to the City Council on the progress of the actions required to meet the obligations assumed by the City specifically to address unauthorized municipal approvals in the consent agreement entered into with Miami-Dade County DERM and approved by Hialeah, Fla. Resolution 2020-013 (January 28, 2020) on a quarterly basis beginning in May 2020 and every three months thereafter at a regularly scheduled meeting of the Council until the term of the consent agreement ends or all obligations are met.

**Section 2:** This resolution shall become effective upon signature of the Mayor of the City of Hialeah, Florida or at the next regularly scheduled City Council meeting, if the Mayor's signature is withheld or if the City Council overrides the Mayor's veto.


