EMERGENCY CURFEW ORDER FOR THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORDIA (AMENDED TO CHANGE START OF CITY CURFEW FROM 11:00 P.M. TO 10:00 P.M.)

WHEREAS, on March 30, 2020, Governor Ron DeSantis issued Executive Order Number 20-89 to establish uniformity and consistency in restricted public access mandates in the Miami-Dade, Broward, Palm Beach and Monroe Counties; and

WHEREAS, on April 1, 2020, Governor Ron DeSantis issued Executive Order Number 20-91 and 20-92 imposing a statewide “stay at home” order to all persons except when engaged in essential services or essential activities as provided in Executive Order 20-91; and

WHEREA, on Monday, March 16, 2020 at 10:23 a.m., I declared a State of Local Emergency for the City of Hialeah, Florida, which remains in effect through April 20, 2020, and in response to the threat to the public’s health, well-being and life posed by COVID-19 imposed a curfew on all persons in the City beginning on Monday, March 30, 2020 until lifted, during the hours of 11:00 p.m. and 5:00 a.m.; and

WHEREAS, in order to avoid confusion of the residents in Miami-Dade County it is imperative that curfew hours are uniform and consistent with those of other cities in Miami-Dade County.

THEREFORE, in response to the impending risk to the life, health, safety and welfare posed by Coronavirus Disease 2019 (COVID-19) to our citizenry and pursuant to the authority provided by F.S. Chapter 252, and in particular F.S. §252.38 and in furtherance of all national, state, county and local emergency orders issued to date;

In order to safeguard the life, health, safety and welfare of the residents of the City of Hialeah;
and

In an attempt to slow the spread and mitigate the potential impact of Coronavirus Disease;

Effective 10:00 p.m., Tuesday, April 14, 2020, I HEREBY ORDER:


1. A curfew in the City of Hialeah shall remain in effect as ordered by Emergency Curfew Order issued of Monday, March 30, 2020 at 10:30 a.m. and as amended on April 2, 2020 at 3:00 p.m., subject to the change in curfew hours provided in this Order.
2. The curfew shall be in effect during the hours of **10:00 p.m. until 5:00 a.m.** the following day, and each consecutive day thereafter until the curfew is lifted and this Order rescinded.
3. This Emergency Curfew Order shall be strictly adhered to at all times and enforceable pursuant to Florida law.

ORDERED at 5:30 p.m. on this 13th day of April, 2020 before the undersigned witnesses.




