RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, ACCEPTING THE DONATION OF ONE HUNDRED THOUSAND DOLLARS TO THE CITY OF HIALEAH FROM DEEM, LLC TO BE USED BY THE CITY FOR THE DESIGN AND INSTALLATION OF TWO CITY OF HIALEAH ENTRANCE FEATURES ONE TO BE LOCATED AT INTERSECTION OF NW 97 AVENUE AND NW 138 STREET AND THE OTHER AT THE INTERSECTION OF NW 97 AVENUE AND NW 170 STREET; PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, DEEM, LLC wishes to donate one hundred thousand dollars to be used by the City for the design and installation of two City of Hialeah entrance features one to be located at NW 97th Avenue at the intersection of NW 138th Street and the other at NW 97th Avenue and NW 170th street; and

**WHEREAS**, the City Council finds that the donation serves both a charitable and public purpose as the entrance features will provide the public a convenient signpost to their destination, a distinctive mark for the city's residents and businesses, to visitors, and to future businesses and residents.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

**Section 1:** The foregoing facts and recitations contained in the preamble to this resolution are hereby adopted and incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein.

**Section 2:** The City of Hialeah hereby accepts the donation and the Mayor or his designee is authorized to execute the documents necessary to complete the donation.




