

**RESOLUTION NO. 2020-069**

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA AMENDING HIALEAH, FLA. RESOLUTION NO. 2020-062 APPROVED (MAY 26, 2020) CREATING THE CITY OF HIALEAH 2020 CENSUS COMMITTEE; AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

**WHEREAS**, Councilmember Jesus Tundidor desires an amendment to the membership of the census committee.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:

**Section 1.** Resolution No. 2020-062 approved on May 26, 2020 creating the City of Hialeah 2020 Census Committee is hereby amended as follows:

Membership. The committee shall consist of 7 voting members, which shall be appointed by the Hialeah City Council. The members shall consist of the following persons with a physical presence in the city:

1. A business owner: **Zachary Swanson, Unbranded Brewing Company**
2. Hialeah Housing Authority: **Julio Ponce Executive Director**
3. City Employee: **Mario Pico, Hialeah Fire Union**
4. Education: **Marta Rios, Social Worker, James H. Bright**
5. Resident of Hialeah: **Eddie Santiesteban**
6. Media: **Angela Ramos, Director of Community Empowerment**
7. Hospital System: **Michael Bell, Hialeah Hospital CEO**

**Council Member Jesus Tundidor shall be the Chair of the committee and shall be responsible for the management and supervision of the committee and for carrying out policies adopted by the committee.**

**Section 2: Effective Date.** This resolution shall become effective upon signature of the

Mayor of the City of Hialeah, Florida or at the next regularly scheduled City Council meeting, if the Mayor's signature is withheld or if the City Council overrides the Mayor's veto.




