

RESOLUTION NO. 2020-149

RESOLUTION OF THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, APPROVING THE EXPENDITURE IN AN AMOUNT NOT TO EXCEED \$20,510.00 FROM THE LAW ENFORCEMENT TRUST FUND-FEDERAL AND 2018 TO 2020 DOJ JAG GRANT ACCOUNTS FOR THE COST OF ROLLOUT AND CONFIGURATION SERVICES OF THE NATIONAL INCIDENT-BASED REPORTING SYSTEM (NIBRS) AND FOR A FLORIDA INCIDENT BASED REPORTING USER TRAINING; UPON SUCH COSTS HAVING BEEN APPROVED BY THE CHIEF OF POLICE, AND PROVIDING FOR AN EFFECTIVE DATE.

WHEREAS, the National Incident-Based Reporting System (NIBRS) is an incident-based reporting system used by law enforcement agencies in the United States for collecting and reporting data on crimes committed in the respective agency's jurisdiction; and

WHEREAS, on December 2, 2015, the Criminal Justice Information Services Division's Advisory Policy Board (APB) approved the recommendation to sunset the traditional Summary Reporting System (SRS) and replace it with the National Incident-Based Reporting System (NIBRS) by January 1, 2021; and

WHEREAS, the Hialeah Police Department currently utilizes the Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR) Program; and

WHEREAS, the Uniform Crime Reporting (UCR) Program transition from summary to incident-based data in the National Incident-Based Reporting System (NIBRS) is needed to meet the national standard for crime reporting; and

WHEREAS, National Incident-Based Reporting System (NIBRS) will capture details on each crime incident, as well as on separate offenses within the same incident, including information on victims, known offenders, relationships between victims and offenders, arrestees, and property involved in crimes. Unlike data reported through the UCR Program's traditional Summary Reporting System (SRS)—an aggregate monthly tally of crimes— National Incident-Based Reporting System (NIBRS) goes much deeper because of its ability to provide circumstances and context for crimes like location, time of day, and whether the incident was cleared; and

WHEREAS, the use of National Incident-Based Reporting System (NIBRS) will assist the Hialeah Police Department in quantifying crime in our community and assessing use of resources more strategically and effectively; and

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WHEREAS, funds are needed to assist in transitioning to the operations of the National Incident-Based Reporting System (NIBRS); and

WHEREAS, the cost of rollout and configuration service in addition to a five-day user training is \$20,510 as set forth in “Exhibit 1”; and

WHEREAS, funding for this project will be as follows: \$16,760.35 from account 127.1000.521310 Law Enforcement Trust Fund-Federal, \$1,566.00 from 2018 DOJ JAH Grant Account 121.1000.521495, \$1,097.65 from 2019 DOJ JAG Grant account 121.1000.521498, and \$1,086.00 from 2020 DOJ JAG Grant account 121.1000.521495; and

WHEREAS, Section 932.7055, Fla. Stat. (2018), the Florida Contraband and Forfeiture Act, authorizes the expenditure of Law Enforcement Trust Funds-Federal for this purpose and the funds are available in the Law Enforcement Trust Fund-Federal account for the Police Department; and

WHEREAS, the Edward Byrne Memorial Justice Assistance (JAG) Program of the Department of Justice (DOJ) allows for such expenditure from grant award issued to the Hialeah Police Department from fiscal years 2018 through 2020; and

WHEREAS, the Chief of Police of the Hialeah Police Department has recommended adoption of this resolution and determined that the proposed expenditure complies with the Florida Contraband Forfeiture Act, and all applicable rules, regulations and guidelines governing the expenditure of Law Enforcement Trust Fund-Federal; and

WHEREAS, the City finds the expenditure is in the public interest;

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED BY THE MAYOR AND THE CITY COUNCIL OF THE CITY OF HIALEAH, FLORIDA, THAT:


Section 1: The foregoing facts and recitations contained in the preamble to this resolution are hereby adopted and incorporated by reference as if fully set forth herein.

Section 2: The City of Hialeah, Florida hereby approves the expenditure of an amount not exceeding a total amount of \$20,510.00 (\$16,760.35 from Law Enforcement Trust Fund-Federal account, \$1,566.00 from 2018 DOJ JAH Grant Account, \$1,097.65 from 2019 DOJ JAG Grant account, and \$1,086.00 from 2020 DOJ JAG Grant account) for the rollout and configuration services of the National Incident-Based Reporting System (NIBRS) and for Florida Incident Based

Reporting User Training, upon such costs having been approved by the Chief of Police of the Hialeah Police Department having specifications and pursuant to the terms and conditions as set forth in "Exhibit 1."

Section 3: This resolution shall become effective when passed by the City Council and signed by the Mayor.






